## ALAMEDA COUNTY EMPLOYERS

Are you facing the challenge of retaining valuable employees who are leaving due to high housing costs and extended commutes?

Yes Absolutely

In November 2016, Alameda County voters approved the Measure A1 Affordable Housing Bond. This bond includes funding for AC Boost, the County's Down Payment Assistance Loan Program. The program **helps middle-income working households to purchase a home in Alameda County**. First-time homebuyers who live in, work in, or have been displaced from Alameda County can receive a shared equity loan of **up to \$210,000** through this program.



## AC Boost is here to help!

- Employees whose primary job site is located in Alameda County are eligible.
- Annual household income must not exceed 120% of Area Median Income (e.g. \$177,500 for a household of 4).
- Must be "first time" homebuyers who have not owned a home in last 3 years.
